COVID-19 pandemic: Qatar Contributions

Qatar contributed generously to mitigate the effects of COVID-19 through providing financial support and medical supplies to many developing countries. It also contributed \$20 million to the Global Alliance for Vaccines and immunization (GAVI) and \$10 million to the World Health Organization (WHO) and supported the humanitarian initiative to raise \$100 million to provide vaccines.



Development of a competitive and diversified economy capable of meeting the needs of, and securing a high standard of living, all its people both for the present.




Environmental development
