Austria in a Nutshell

Austria is situated in Central Europe over an area of 83,879 Km² and is bordered by Slovakia and Hungary from the east, Switzerland and Liechtenstein from the west, Germany and the Czech Republic from the north, and Slovenia and Italy from the south. the southIts population reached 9.062 million inhabitants in 2022.

The country celebrates its National Day on October 26 and is administratively divided into 9 federal provinces: Vienna (the capital/German: Wien), Upper Austria (German: Oberösterreich), Lower Austria (German: Niederösterreich), Styria (German: Steiermark), Carinthia (German: Kärnten), Salzburg, Tyrol (German: Tirol), Vorarlberg, and Burgenland.

Moreover, Austria has been a member state of the United Nations since 1955, a member of the European Union since 1995, and of the Schengen zone since 1997. For decades now, the Austrian capital is home to one of the three United Nations headquarters, next to New York and Geneva.

Vienna Tops the Economist Intelligence Unit's 2022 Global Liveability Index


According to the latest annual ranking of the world's most liveable cities released by the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU), Vienna has come atop the EIU's 2022 Global Liveability Index, ranking for the third time in the past five years, thanks to the plethora of opportunities that Vienna provides for culture, entertainment and gastronomy, as well as its impeccable infrastructure and overall safety and stability.

This survey ranked 173 cities around the world based on various factors, such as healthcare, crime rates, political stability, infrastructure and access to green spaces.

The City of Vienna's recent publication "Vienna in Figures 2022" shows that Vienna was home to people from 179 different nationalities as of 1 January 2022, the top 5 nationalities being Serbian (4%), German (2.8%), Turkish (2.3%), Polish (2.3%), and Romanian (2%).

Vienna Receives Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize for High Quality of life and Sustainable Urban Transformation

In March 2022, the Republic of Singapore awarded the City of Vienna the "Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize 2020".

Mayor Michael Ludwig accepted the internationally renowned award in August at the World Cities Summit 2022 in Singapore.

The biennial award presented by the Southeast Asian city-state recognises outstanding achievements and contributions to the creation of liveable, vibrant and sustainable urban communities around the world.

Above all, Vienna's combination of history and modernity convinced the jury. The city builds on its strong cultural and historical foundations, while at the same time being a sustainable and liveable metropolis thanks to modern innovations.

The fact that the Viennese can actively participate in the development of their city was also positively emphasised, as was the city's long tradition in public services and the high quality of services for all citizens. Vienna is a role model for urban development and renewal as well as sustainable growth. Worthy of noting are the measures for environmental protection and climate change daptation, such as the creation of more open and green spaces.

The concept of strengthening many local centres and lively districts, such as in Seestadt Aspern or the Nordbahnhof area, was also praised, where short distances between living, working and leisure spaces promote active mobility like cycling or walking and thus also improve the health of the Viennese.

Furthermore, Vienna's offer to its residents to get actively involved through initiatives such as the "Grätzln" was also stressed, with which Viennese of all generations and cultures can live in harmony with one another and also have a say in new measures to optimise cohesion.

Smart Climate City Strategy Vienna: the Way to Becoming a Model Climate City

As early as 2014, the Vienna City Council set an initial milestone for combating the causes of climate change and dealing with its consequences with the Smart City Wien framework strategy – with a target horizon of 2050.

In 2020, the goal of climate neutrality by 2040 was anchored in the "Wiener Regierungsübereinkommen" (Government Agreement).

With this claim, Vienna is reaffirming its commitment to global and European climate goals. Therefore, a renewed revision of the Vienna Smart City objectives was tackled.

The strategy is also based on all of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the UN Agenda 2030. The Vienna City Council decided on the revised Smart City Strategy Vienna on February 23, 2022.



The Smart City Vienna mission remains the same:

"High quality of life for everyone in Vienna through social and technical innovation in all areas, while maximising conservation of resources."

The Smart Climate City Strategy Vienna is the umbrella strategy for the city's climate package. It works hand in hand with the **Klima-Fahrplan** (Climate Roadmap, German only), which uses practical measures to make the goals on the path to becoming a model climate city tangible.

Another pillar is the Wiener Klimarat (Vienna Climate Council), which was set up in 2019. Scientists, experts, employees of the City of Vienna and representatives from politics, business and civil society advise politics and administration on climate politics projects.



The international economic downturn also affected the Austrian economy in the second half of 2022. GDP is expected to decline in the winter halfyear. Stimulus from foreign trade is expected to revive in spring 2023. The gradual easing on the energy markets is dampening inflation and should contribute to an improvement in sentiment over time and a pick-up in economic activity. In 2022, Austria's economic output will grow by 4.7%. In 2023, GDP is expected to largely stagnate (0.3%), while in 2024 growth will increase to 1.8%.

"The situation on the energy markets eased noticeably in autumn. On the futures markets, prices are expected to be significantly lower in 2023 than in summer 2022. However, there is still a risk of a renewed sharp increase in prices," says Stefan Ederer, one of the authors of the current WIFO forecast.

The global economy is currently in a weak phase. High energy and commodity prices are driving consumer price inflation in many countries and prompting a rapid tightening of monetary policy. Sentiment has deteriorated in many places and uncertainty about future developments is high. The economic downturn, which had already started earlier in the USA, is now also clearly evident in the euro area and is likely to lead to a decline in economic output there in winter.

However, the situation on the commodity markets has eased somewhat recently. Oil prices have already been falling since the summer; in autumn, higher-than-expected inventories dampened European natural gas prices. Nevertheless, these will remain elevated for the time being and will not fall noticeably until the second half of 2023. Tighter global monetary conditions will dampen demand over the forecast period, which, together with the slowdown in commodity prices, should curb inflation. This in turn should lift household and business sentiment and support economic activity. However, global economic growth will be weak in 2023 and will not pick up noticeably until 2024. The global economic downturn also affected Austria in the third quarter of 2022. Exports and the value added of domestic industry contracted, while aggregate output stagnated.Persistently high energy prices, strong price dynamics and uncertainty about future developments are depressing sentiment. Subsequently, nonetheless, the Austrian economy should recover. From spring 2023 onwards, noticeable impulses can be expected again from abroad. In addition, private consumption and investments will stabilise as uncertainty recedes and the situation on the energy markets gradually eases. The development of real wages per capita will also contribute to the revival of the economy: after declining in 2021 and 2022, real wages will rise again in 2023.

In 2022, Austria's GDP grew by 4.7 % (preliminary) due to the strong economic activity in the first half of the year. In 2023, however, economic output will largely stagnate (0.3%) and only return to significant growth in 2024 (1.8%).

The situation on the labour market remains favourable and is expected to deteriorate only temporarily as a result of the economic downturn. After a significant decline in 2022 (6.3%), the unemployment rate will rise slightly to 6.5% in 2023 due to weaker employment dynamics and fall back to 6.2% in 2024.

Inflation is likely to have already peaked. Consumer prices after rising by 8.5% in 2022, inflation will slow down to 6.5% in 2023. The gradual decline in energy prices dampens inflation despite high wage increases; in 2024, consumer prices will thus only rise by 3.2%.


The favourable labour market situation and the expiry of the COVID-19 support measures improve the fiscal balance in 2022. In the following years, the deficit is expected to fall well below the Maastricht limit of 3% of GDP again, as a number of support measures to cushion the rise in energy prices are discontinued and economic activity gradually picks up again.








Economic Growth 1996 - 2024 change of real GDP (in %)








Inflation rate 1995 - 2024




Capital Formation 1996 - 2024 real change (in %)



Public Deficit 1995 - 2024 net lending (Maastricht-definition), % of GDP






