Nestled amidst the majestic Alps, Austria encompasses 83,879 square kilometres, and despite its moderate size, boasts a population of over 9 million, with the vibrant capital Vienna housing more than 2 million residents. The remaining population resides in nine federal provinces: Burgenland, Carinthia, Lower Austria, Upper Austria, Salzburg, Styria, Tyrol, Vorarlberg, and Vienna itself.

Austria commands a remarkable global presence that transcends its geographical boundaries. Serving as the headquarters for over 40 international organizations, alongside approximately 130 bilateral and numerous multilateral diplomatic missions, Austria stands as a pivotal hub for international diplomacy. Towards a Greener Future: Embracing Sustainability Initiatives

Ranked 5th in the 2023 Sustainable Development Goals Index, the nation holds several impressive titles:

- Renewable Energy: Over 70% of Austria's electricity comes from renewable sources, primarily hydropower and solar. This surpasses the EU average of 38% and places Austria amongst the global leaders in renewable energy consumption.
- Green Tech Pioneer: According to the Global Innovation Index 2023, Austria ranks 16th globally in innovation, with notable strengths in clean energy and environmental technologies. Its investments in green research and development fuel continued advancements in sustainable solutions.
- Climate Action: Committed to the Paris Agreement, Austria aims for climate neutrality by 2040. The country actively implements initiatives to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, including ambitious energy efficiency targets and a focus on decarbonization

The Green Gold - Austria's Excellent Water Quality

Austria stands out in Europe for its water quality. Many lakes and rivers boast drinking water quality. According to a recent EU study, 99.2 percent of 260 surveyed domestic bathing sites are classified as "excellent" or "good". Austria's tap water ranks in the highest quality category globally and is the least calcareous water in the entire DACH region. In contrast to many other countries, Austria can meet almost all of its drinking water needs from protected groundwater sources. It is even recommended to prefer tap water in Austria over bottled water from the supermarket – even in a metropolis like Vienna. Since 1873, the finest mountain spring water has been flowing into Viennese households.







In its capacity as one of the most prosperous and stable members of the European Union, Austria presents an attractive environment for investors. Characterized by a free market economy with a strong social orientation that prioritizes the welfare of all segments of society, Austria boasts a well-established framework of economic and social cooperation.



Austria stands as a highly developed industrial nation with a thriving service sector. While the total GDP (Gross Domestic Product) in 2023 amounted to 477.25 billion EUR, the service sector accounts for two third of the whole value creation. Especially tourism plays a vital role in the Austrian economy, with the country's picturesque landscapes offering ample opportunities for leisure and recreation.




Agriculture Sector

In agriculture, Austria is witnessing a notable shift towards organic farming, with organic farms holding a leading position among EU Member States with almost 30% of organic production.

With abundant natural resources such as iron ore, non-ferrous metals, minerals, and earths, Austria maintains a robust foundation for raw materials and energy production. However, the growing industrial sector necessitates increased reliance on supplementary imports, particularly in fuels, energy resources, and electricity generation. While possessing its own petroleum and natural gas resources, Austria is a pioneer in hydroelectric power generation within the European Union.

Production Sector

Austria's industrial and commercial landscape is marked by a significant presence of medium-sized enterprises, serving as the backbone of the Austrian economy and covering a wide spectrum from basic manufacturing to highly processed goods. Significantly, machinery production represents the largest portion, succeeded by metal production and processing, food and animal feed production, manufacturing of metal products, motor vehicles and their components, and manufacturing of electrical equipment. Noteworthy is the substantial export share of these products, particularly in mechanical engineering, where export rates reach as high as 80%.



Besides the industrial production, Austria is also renowned for its fine craftsmanship in areas such as jewellery, ceramics, and glassware, Austria and enjoys global recognition for its arts and crafts tradition.

Service Sector

Amidst the backdrop of a stagnating GDP in 2023, the service sector emerged as a stalwart pillar of Austria's economy, demonstrating notable resilience, particularly within the domains of financial and economic services, as well as the enduring stronghold of tourism. Notably, tourism remains a cornerstone of Austria's economic framework. In the preceding year of 2022, Austria experienced a significant influx of foreign visitors, culminating in a total of almost 136.91 million overnight stays. Primarily, visitors originated from key source markets such as Germany, The Netherlands, United Kingdom, Czech Republic, Italy, and Switzerland.

Navigating the Economic Terrain: Present Realities and Future Prospects

"The prosperity in Austria grew less vigorously in 2022 than suggested by the real GDP per capita, as high import prices diminished purchasing power. The real value of the GDP better reflects the development. It also indicates that the prosperity in 2023 does not decline as sharply as a recession would suggest." (WIFO Report on the Economic Outlook, 1/2024)

Charting the Economic Voyage: A Retrospective of 2022-2023

Austria's economic journey between 2022 and 2023 was a tightrope walk between the lingering echoes of recovery and the sudden gusts of global headwinds. After a strong 4.8% GDP growth in 2022, the nation faced unexpected challenges like the war in Ukraine, which disrupted supply chains, sent energy prices soaring, and sparked a global inflation shock. This slowed momentum in 2023, with growth projections hovering around -0.8%. Inflation peaked at 11.2% in early 2023, putting pressure on household budgets and dampening consumer confidence.

Although faced with these challenges, the year also saw notable positive developments. The tourism sector, long dormant due to the pandemic, made a strong comeback, particularly during the summer months. This revival, fuelled by pent-up travel demand, gave the service industry a much-needed boost. Austria's manufacturing sector, a pillar of its economic strength, remained firm, driven by exports of high-tech and machinery products. Unemployment remained relatively low, averaging around 6.4%, showcasing the stability of the labour market.

Private consumption, a key driver of Austria's 2021 rebound, also played a crucial role in 2022 and 2023. While initial enthusiasm waned due to inflationary pressures, the Austrian government implemented measures like tax cuts and energy subsidies to bolster consumer confidence and spending power. These interventions helped maintain private consumption as a stabilizing force amidst external shocks.

Yet, amidst these strengths, a watchful eye must be kept on Austria's credit rating. While major agencies like S&P Global Ratings and Fitch affirmed Austria's "AA+/A-1+" long- and short-term sovereign credit ratings in August 2023, they also revised the outlook to "stable" from "positive". This indicates that while Austria's creditworthiness remains high, its ability to further improve its rating in the near future is limited due to the current economic uncertainties.

Horizons Ahead: Forecasting the Economic Landscape

Looking ahead, Austria's economic outlook is characterized by a degree of uncertainty. The trajectory of the Ukraine war and its consequential impact on energy security and inflation are significant factors of concern. Moreover, geopolitical tensions and their ramifications on global trade introduce further complexity to the situation. Nonetheless, there exist several key strengths that provide grounds for optimism.


Austria boasts a resilient and internationally acclaimed manufacturing sector supported by a skilled and adaptable workforce. Additionally, its dedication to research and development fosters innovation, thereby enhancing its competitive position. Furthermore, the proactive stance of the government, as evidenced by targeted interventions and a commitment to prudent spending, underscores its resolve to navigate challenges and secure future prosperity.

In the year 2023, while private consumption serves as a driver for economic growth in the United States, the GDP within the Eurozone experiences stagnation. However, with notable increases in real incomes due to wage adjustments and a resurgence in industrial production, there is optimistic anticipation for the European economy to regain momentum in 2024.

Conversely, Austria anticipates a modest decline of approximately 0.8% in its economic performance for 2023. Nonetheless, projections indicate that the trough of this economic downturn is likely to be reached by the end of the year. Looking ahead, Austria foresees a recovery, with the GDP expected to grow by 0.2% in 2024, followed by a more substantial growth of 1.8% in 2025. Regarding inflation, a deceleration is expected, with a forecasted rate of 3.8% in 2024 and approximately 2.7% in 2025. Notably, energy prices are anticipated to have a minor dampening effect on inflation in 2024.

As industrial activity rebounds from mid-2024, export momentum is likely to accelerate, with growth projections of 1.2% in 2024 and 3.8% in 2025. However, global demand, particularly from Germany for capital goods, may initially remain subdued, impeding a more rapid export recovery. In the meantime, economic research institutes base their positive forecasts mainly on a revitalized private consumption due to increased real wages. While 2023 witnessed a decline in private consumption, attributed to the lag in adjusting to high inflation rates and wage adjustments, a rebound of 2.1% in real private consumption is predicted until 2025.

The fiscal landscape is poised for notable improvement in 2023, attributable to the phasing out of pandemic-related support measures. Projections indicate a substantial enhancement in the public budget balance, with the general government net lending as of the Maastricht definition anticipated to contract to 2.7% of GDP by 2025. Concurrently, a reduction of approximately 5 percentage points in public debt is envisaged over the forecast period, culminating in a public debt-to-GDP ratio of 73.5% in 2025.



Global Connections: Austria's Dynamic Trade Landscape

Traditionally, international trade plays a crucial role in Austria, due to the geographically limited local market, hence the country is historically marked by a relatively high export quota of around 60% of GDP. However, mainly due to the dependency of energy imports, Austria is traditionally characterized by a slight trade deficit. Caused by the energy crisis, the trade deficit was above 3% in 2021 and 2022, but significantly recovered again below 1% in 2023.



Like in the years before, again in 2023 Austria's main trade partner by volume is by far Germany. While the USA is the trade partner with the largest positive trade balance for Austria, the trade with China is typically characterized by higher imports. The list is continued mainly by partners of the European Union, due to the geographical proximity and the European single market which facilitates trade.

In terms of manufactured goods, Mechanical engineering, vehicles and automotive parts, Iron, Steel and metal goods as well as food and drinks are leading the ranking, while tourism tops the service sector exports.

When examining trade at a more detailed level, it becomes evident that foreign trade is predominantly initiated within one of Austria's 9 Federal Provinces. In terms of global trade relations, Upper Austria shines as the perennial export champion, while Vienna stands out as the primary contributor to the highest import volumes, painting a vivid picture of regional trade dynamics.

The Economic Ripples of Geopolitical Strife

While there are currently several geopolitical conflicts ongoing, their economic effect on Austria is currently still limited.

For example, the effects of the conflicts in the Middle East on Austria are primarily indirect. While Austria may not experience direct economic consequences, its repercussions can still be felt through trade disruptions, diplomatic strains, humanitarian efforts, and security considerations. The risk of an oil price shock similar to the 1973 oil embargo appears limited as the Western dependency decreased due to the USA being a net exporter of crude oil itself now. However, a closure of important trade routes, such as the Suez Canal, is conceivable and could lead to renewed supply chain problems.


On the other hand, the ongoing conflict in Ukraine remains a significant source of risk. Coupled with an exceptionally cold winter, there exists the possibility of a rapid depletion of gas supplies in Europe, particularly as the region still relies on imports of natural gas and crude oil from Russia. Such scarcity could potentially result in renewed price escalations for natural gas and fuel.


Real Income Development 1996 - 2025

(inflation-adjusted) change to previous year (%)




Economic Growth 1996 - 2025 change in real GDP (in %)




Economic Growth 1996 - 2025 change of real GDP (in %)





Inflation rate 1995 - 2025 change of consumer price index (%)


Manufacturing: contribution to GDP 1996 - 2025 real change of value added (in %)

وتتمتع دولة النمسا بوجود عالمي ملحوظ يتجاوز حدودها الجغرافية. حيث تُعدّ مقرا لأكثر من 40 منظمة دولية، إلى جانب نحو 130 بعثة دبلوماسية ثنائية وعدد كبير من البعثات الدبلوماسية المتعددة الأطراف، وهو ما يجعل النمسا مركزا رئيسا للدبلوماسية الدولية. ويؤكد التميز في استضافة عدة منظمات دولية بارزة، مثل منظمة الدول المصدرة للنفط (أوبك)، والأمم المتحدة، ومنظمة منظمة الأمن والتعاون الأوروبي، على التزام النمسا الراسخ بتعزيز الأمن والسلم العالميين، وتوطيد الجهود المشتركة على المستوى الدولى.




إن موقع النمسا المركزي في أوروبا يجعل منها بوابة استراتيجية إلى الأسواق الشرقية والغربية على حد سواء، مما يوفر إمكانية ولوج مواتية إلى الاقتصادات الأوروبية الرئيسية.

وتتميز النمسا بقوة عمل متعلمة ومحترفة، ويُعرَف عمالها بأخلاق عمل رصينة واحترافية في مختلف القطاعات. كما يحتل نظام التعليم النمساوي المرتبة التاسعة بين 63 دولة حول العالم من حيث التنافسية في المواهب، وذلك وفقًا لتقرير معهد التنمية الإدارية العالميDevelopment (IMD) لعام 2023. علاوة على ذلك، فإن البنية التحتية المتميزة في النمسا، بما في ذلك الشبكات النقل المتطورة وأنظمة الطاقة الآمنة، تسهل عمليات تداول الأعمال بسلاسة وتعزز من إمكانيات التواصل.

وبناء على التصنيفات المستمرة العالية عالميا في مؤشرات جودة الحياة، توفر النمسا بيئة معيشية استثنائية، تمكن من اجتذاب الكفاءات العالية وتعزز الارتقاء المهني والشخصي. وتشير عدة تصنيفات دولية إلى أن العاصمة النمساوية فيينا تحتل المرتبة الأولى عالميًا كأفضل مدينة في العالم من حيث جودة المعيشة. ويضاف إلى ذلك، الشهرة المتنامية للنمسا في مجال الابتكارات والتقدم التكنولوجي، جنبا إلى جنب مع نظام بيئي مزدهر ودعم قوي لمبادرات البحث والتطوير.

وبصورة عامة، فإن النمسا تُعد الاختيار الأنسب للمختصين وللشركات الباحثة عن الاستقرار والموقع الاستراتيجي والمواهب المهارية والبنية التحتية الممتازة وجودة الحياة والفرص للابتكار.



فيينا.. جودة حياة استثنائية

تحتل العاصمة النمساوية فيينا سنويا المرتبة الأولى في العالم من حيث جودة الحياة، وفق مؤشرات التصنيف العالمية، ولا يرجع ذلك إلى ما تتميز به من طرز العمارة الباروكية الرائعة والقصور الإمبراطورية المنتشرة بين ربوعها، وحسب؛ إن فيينا تمتاز بنظام مواصلات متطور للغاية وبأسعار مناسبة للجميع، وهو ما يجعل كل زاوية من زوايا المدينة متاح الوصول إليها بسهولة ويسر. كما يتمتع سكان فيينا بمساحات خضراء مترامية، سواء الحدائق العامة الشاسعة أو غابات فيينا الخضراء، وهو ما يعزز الشعور بالرفاهية. بالإضافة إلى ذلك، فإن فيينا تتميز بمشهد ثقافي دسم، وعامر بالمتاحف العالمية الشهيرة وقاعات الحفلات والمواقع التاريخية. هذا المزيج من العروض الثقافية، بالإضافة إلى نظام صحي قوي واقتصاد قوى، يخلق بيئة مواتية للسكان لتحقيق الازدهار.

وإلى جانب جودة الحياة الاستثنائية التي تتميز بها العاصمة النمساوية، فإن جاذبية فيينا تمتد لتشمل السكان الدوليين وانخراطهم في مجتمعها الثقافي المتنوع المزدهر واستعدادها لاستقبال للأجانب. وفي ظل شغل فيينا المرتبة الأولى في تصنيف ميرسر لجودة الحياة في المدن لعام 2023، الصادر عن وكالة الاستشارات الرائدة ميرسر، فإنها مفعمة بجو ترحيبي وسهولة الاستيطان، مدفوعة بعدة عوامل؛ منها الرعاية الصحية الممتازة وأسعار السكن المعقولة نسبيا، وما تتميز به من بيئة آمنة. وتتعزز هذه الروح الترحيبية بمرتبة النمسا المتميزة في تقييم مهارة اللغة الإنجليزية عالميًا، والذي أجرته منظمة EF؛ حيث جاءت في المرتبة الثالثة. هذه الطلاقة الواسعة في استخدام اللغة، خاصة بين الأجيال الشابة، تعزز من التواصل السلس والتبادل الثقافي، وهو ما يجعل فيينا مجتمعًا مفتوحًا ومتصلًا عالميًا، يستقبل بترحيب الأعمال الدولية والاستثمار والسكان على اختلاف أعراقهم.





نحو مستقبل أخضر.. تبني مبادرات الاستدامة

تحتل النمسا المرتبة الخامسة في الوفاء بأهداف الدليل الأممي للتنمية المستدامة لعام 2023؛ حيث تسجل عدد من الإنجازات ذات الصلة، مثل:

- الطاقة المتجددة: فإن ما يزيد على 70% من إمدادات الكهرباء في النمسا تأتي من مصادر متجددة، وبشكل أساسي الطاقة الهيدروليكية (المائية) والطاقة الشمسية. وتتجاوز هذه النسبة المتوسط الأوروبي البالغ 38%، وهو ما يضع النمسا في موقع الريادة عالميا في استهلاك الطاقة المتجددة.
- رائدة في التكنولوجيا الخضراء: وفقًا لمؤشر الابتكار العالمي لعام 2023، تحتل النمسا المرتبة السادسة عشرة عالميًا في المجال الابتكاري، مع نقاط قوة ملحوظة في مجالات الطاقة النظيفة وتكنولوجيا البيئة. وتستثمر البلاد في البحث والتطوير في مجال التكنولوجيا الخضراء لدفع عجلة التقدم المستدام قُدما.
- إجراءات المناخ: من خلال التزامها باتفاقية باريس للمناخ، وضعت النمسا لنفسها هدف الوصول إلى الحياد الكربوني بحلول عام 2040. وتنفذ البلاد بنشاط مبادرات للحد من انبعاثات الغازات الدفيئة، بما فى ذلك تحديات طموحة لتحسين كفاءة الطاقة والتركيز على الوصول إلى انبعاثات صفر كربون.

الذهب الأخضر - جودة المياه الممتازة في النمسا

تتميز النمسا في أوروبا بجودة مياهها، حيث تتمتع العديد من البحيرات والأنهار بجودة مياه الشرب. ووفقًا لدراسة أوروبية حديثة، يُصنف 99.2 % من مواقع الاستحمام المحلية، والبالغ عددها 260، بأنها "ممتازة" أو "جيدة". وتتصدر مياه الصنبور في النمسا فئة الجودة العالية عالميًا، وتُعتبر من أقل المياه جيريةً في المنطقة التي تضم معها كل من ألمانيا وسويسرا. وعلى عكس العديد من البلدان الأخرى، يمكن للنمسا تلبية احتياجاتها في الشرب من مصادر المياه الجوفية المحمية. حتى يُفضل استخدام مياه الصنبور في النمسا على مياه الزجاجات المعبأة في المتاجر - حتى في مدينة كبيرة مثل فيينا، تتدفق مياه الينابيع الجبلية النقية إلى منازل العاصمة منذ عام 1873.







استنادا على حقيقة كونها واحدة من أكثر الدول ازدهارا واستقرارا بين دول الاتحاد الأوروبي، تتيح النمسا بيئة جاذبة للمستثمرين، وتتميز باقتصاد سوق حر مع توجه اجتماعي قوي يعطي أولوية لرفاهية جميع شرائح المجتمع؛ حيث تفتخر النمسا بإطار متين من التعاون الاقتصادي والاجتماعي.



تُعدّ النمسا دولة صناعية متطورة بقطاع خدمات مزدهر، وبلغ الناتج المحلي الإجمالي في عام 2023 نحو 477.25 مليار يورو، بينما يمثل قطاع الخدمات ثلثي قيمة الإنتاج الكلي. وتلعب السياحة بصفة خاصة دورًا حيويًا في الاقتصاد النمساوي؛ حيث تتيح المناظر الطبيعية الخلابة في البلاد فرصًا متنوعة للترفيه والاستجمام.





قطاع الزراعة

تشهد النمسا تحولًا ملحوظًا نحو الزراعة العضوية؛ حيث تحتل المزارع العضوية مركزًا رائدًا بين الدول الأعضاء في الاتحاد الأوروبي بنسبة تقارب 30% من الإنتاج العضوي. ومع وجود موارد طبيعية وفيرة مثل خام الحديد والمعادن غير الحديدية والمعادن والتربة، تحتفظ النمسا بأساس قوي لإنتاج المواد الخام والطاقة. ومع ذلك، فإن القطاع الصناعي المتنامي يستدعي زيادة الاعتماد على الواردات الإضافية، خاصة في مجال الوقود وموارد الطاقة وإنتاج الكهرباء. وعلى الرغم من وجود موارد خاصة بالنفط والغاز الطبيعي، فإن النمسا تعتبر رائدة أوروبيا في مجال توليد الطاقة الكهرومائية.

قطاع الإنتاج

يتميز القطاع الصناعي والتجاري في النمسا بوجود ملحوظ للشركات ذات الحجم المتوسط، وهو ما يشكل عمودًا فقريًا للاقتصاد النمساوي ويغطي مجموعة واسعة من الصناعات من التصنيع الأساسي إلى السلع المصنعة بشكل متقدم. ويُمثل إنتاج الآلات نسبة كبيرة من هذا القطاع، يليه إنتاج وتصنيع المعادن والمعالجة، وإنتاج الأغذية والأعلاف الحيوانية، وتصنيع المنتجات المعدنية، والمركبات الآلية ومكوناتها، وتصنيع الأجهزة الكهربائية. وتُلاحظ الحصة الكبيرة للتصدير لهذه المنتجات، خاصة في الهندسة الميكانيكية؛ حيث تصل نسب التصدير إلى نحو 80%.



وبالإضافة إلى الإنتاج الصناعي، فإن النمسا تتمتع النمسا بسمعة ممتازة في مجال الحرف اليدوية الراقية مثل المجوهرات والسيراميك وأدوات الزجاج، وتحظى النمسا بتقدير عالمي لتقاليدها في الفنون والحرف اليدوية.

قطاع الخدمات

على خلفية نمو الناتج المحلي الإجمالي الذي تعثر في عام 2023، ظهر قطاع الخدمات كركيزة قوية للاقتصاد النمساوي؛ حيث أبدى مرونة ملحوظة، خاصة في مجالات الخدمات المالية والاقتصادية، بالإضافة إلى دعامة السياحة المتينة، التي تشكل عمودًا أساسيًا في الهيكل الاقتصادي للنمسا. في العام 2022، شهدت النمسا تدفقًا كبيرًا من الزوار الأجانب، مما أدى إلى الوصول إلى إجمالي نحو 136.91 مليون ليلة فندقية. ويأتي السائحون من دول رئيسية مثل ألمانيا وهولندا والمملكة المتحدة والجمهورية التشيكية وإيطاليا وسويسرا.

طريق النمسا الاقتصادي.. الواقع الحالي والآفاق المستقبلية

"The prosperity in Austria grew less vigorously in 2022 than suggested by the real GDP per capita, as high import prices diminished purchasing power. The real value of the GDP better reflects the development. It also indicates that the prosperity in 2023 does not decline as sharply as a recession would suggest." (WIFO Report on the Economic Outlook, 1/2024)

يشير تقرير المعهد النمساوي للأبحاث الاقتصادية الصادر في شهر أبريل 2023، إلى أن النمو في النمسا سار بوتيرة أقل في عام 2022 مما يوحي به الناتج المحلي الإجمالي الفعلي للفرد؛ حيث أدى ارتفاع أسعار الواردات إلى انخفاض القوة الشرائية. ولفت التقرير إلى القيمة الفعلية للناتج المحلي الإجمالي تعكس النمو بشكل أفضل، وأن الازدهار في عام 2023 لا يتراجع بشكل حاد كما يوحى به الركود الاقتصادي.

رحلة اقتصادية مثيرة.. استعادة للأحداث بين عامى 2022 و2023

كانت رحلة النمسا الاقتصادية بين عامي 2022 و2023 مشابهة للمشي على حبل مشدود بين صدى تعافي طويل الأمد ورياح عاتية من الظروف العالمية. فبعد نمو الناتج المحلي الإجمالي بنسبة 4.8% في عام 2022، واجهت البلاد تحديات غير متوقعة مثل الحرب في أوكرانيا، التي أثرت على سلاسل الإمداد، وأدت إلى ارتفاع أسعار الطاقة، وتسببت في حدوث صدمة تضخم عالمية. هذا الوضع أبطأ وتيرة النمو في عام 2023، مع توقعات نمو نحو -8.0%. وبلغ التضخم ذروته عند 11.5% في بداية عام 2023، مما وضع ضغطًا على ميزانيات الأسر وخفّض من ثقة المستهلكين.

وعلى الرغم من هذه التحديات، شهد العام تطورات إيجابية ملحوظة. فقطاع السياحة، الذي كان في حالة سبات طويلة بسبب جائحة كوفيد-19، شهد عودة قوية، خاصة خلال أشهر الصيف. هذا التعافي الذي جاء مدفوعا بالطلب المكبوت على السفر، أعطى دفعة كبيرة لصناعة الخدمات. بينما ظل قطاع التصنيع في النمسا، الذي يعتبر دعامة لقوتها الاقتصادية، ثابتا على قوته، بفضل صادرات المنتجات فائقة التكنولوجيا والآلات. كما ظل معدل البطالة منخفضًا نسبيًا، مع متوسط يبلغ حوالي 6.4%، مما يُظهر استقرارا في سوق العمل.

كذلك فإن الاستهلاك الخاص، الذي كان محرك رئيسي لانتعاش النمسا في عام 2021، لعب دورًا حاسمًا في عام 2022، لعب دورًا حاسمًا في عامي 2022 و2023. وفي الوقت الذي تراجع فيه الحماس الأولي بسبب ضغوط التضخم، اتخذت الحكومة النمساوية تدابير عاجلة مثل خفض الضرائب ودعم الطاقة لتعزيز ثقة المستهلكين وقدرتهم على الإنفاق. وساعدت هذه التدخلات الحكومية في الحفاظ على الاستهلاك الخاص كقوة مثبتة في مواجهة الصدمات الخارجية.

وفي المقابل يتعين الالتفات إلى تصنيف النمسا الائتماني. ففي أغسطس 2023، أكدت وكالات التصنيف الرئيسية مثل S&P Global Ratings و Fitch تصنيف النمسا السيادي الطويل والقصير الأجل على التوالي بـ "AA+/A-1"، ولكنها أيضًا قامت بمراجعة التوقعات إلى "مستقرة" من "إيجابية". وهذا يشير إلى أن رغم بقاء قدرة النمسا على الدفع مرتفعة، إلا أن قدرتها على تحسين تصنيفها في المستقبل القريب محدودة بسبب حالة عدم اليقين الاقتصادي الحالية.

آفاق مستقبلية .. توقعات المشهد الاقتصادي

نظرًا لحالة عدم اليقين المتزايد، تظل الآفاق الاقتصادية للنمسا غير مؤكدة. فمسار الحرب في أوكرانيا وانعكاساتها على أمن الطاقة والتضخم يظلان مصدر قلق رئيسي. فالتوترات الجيوسياسية وتأثيرها على التجارة العالمية تضيف مزيدا من التعقيد على المشهد. وفي مقابل ذلك تبدو هناك عدة نقاط قوة رئيسية تدعوا للتفاؤل. فدولة النمسا تتميز بقطاع صناعي قوي وذي شهرة عالمية، ويدعمه في ذلك قوة عمل ماهرة وقابلة للتكيف. بالإضافة إلى ذلك، فإن حرص النمسا المستمر على البحث والتطوير يعزز من فرص الابتكار، وهو ما يفتح المجال أمام من مزيد من التنافسية. علاوة على ذلك، يظهر النهج الاستباقي للحكومة الواضح في التدخلات المستهدفة والتركيز على الإنفاق المسؤول، التزامها بمواجهة التعقيدات وتفكيكها وتأمين نموا مستقبليا.

وفيما يعتبر الاستهلاك الخاص دعامة للتوسع الاقتصادي في الولايات المتحدة، فقد واجه الناتج المحلي الإجمالي توقفًا في منطقة اليورو في عام 2023.. ومع ذلك، فقد بدت زيادة ملحوظة في الدخل الحقيقي وحالة من الانتعاش في الإنتاج الصناعي، ولذا هناك توقعات متفائلة لاستعادة زخم الاقتصاد الأوروبي في عام 2024.

من ناحية أخرى، توقع للنمسا انخفاضًا متواضعًا بنسبة حوالي 0.8% في أدائها الاقتصادي عام 2023، مع احتمالية الوصول إلى أدنى مستوى لهذا الانخفاض الاقتصادي بحلول نهاية عام 2023. وبنظرة إلى المستقبل، فمن المتوقع أن يشهد عام 2024 بالنمسا نموا في الناتج المحلي الإجمالي بنسبة 0.9%، ثم زيادة أكبر بنسبة 2% في عام 2025. وفيما يتعلق بالتضخم، فمن المتوقع تباطؤه، لتصل معدلات التضخم إلى 4% في عام 2024 وحوالي 3% في عام 2025. كما أنه من المتوقع أن تكون أسعار الطاقة لها تأثير ضئيل فقط على التضخم خلال عام 2024.

ومع فرص استعادة النشاط الصناعي بدءا من منتصف عام 2024، فمن المحتمل أن يتسارع زخم التصدير مرة أخرى. ومع ذلك، ستظل الطلب العالمي على السلع الرأسمالية ضعيفة في البداية، مما يمنع الانتعاش السريع في التصدير. ومن المتوقع أن لا يتم التسارع في التصدير بشكل قوي مرة أخرى حتى عام 2025. كما أنه من المتوقع أن يشهد المشهد المالي تحسنًا ملحوظًا في عام 2023، نتيجة لتدريج إنهاء حزمات التدابير الداعمة المرتبطة بالجائحة. وتشير التوقعات إلى تحسن كبير في رصيد الميزانية العامة؛ حيث من المرتقب أن ينخفض عجز الحكومة إلى 2% من الناتج المحلي الإجمالي بحلول عام 2025. وفي الوقت نفسه، يُتوقع تقليص الدين العام بمقدار حوالي 5 نقاط مئوية خلال الفترة المتوقعة، مما يؤدي إلى نسبة دين عام إلى الناتج المحلي الإجمالي بنسبة 73.5% في عام 2025.





التواصل العالمي.. مشهد تجاري ديناميكي للنمسا

تلعب التجارة الخارجية دورًا حاسمًا في النمسا، نظرًا للسوق المحلية المحدودة جغرافيًا، وبالتالي تتميز البلاد تاريخيًا بنسبة تصدير مرتفعة نسبية تبلغ حوالي 60% من الناتج المحلي الإجمالي. ومع ذلك، وبسبب اعتمادها على استيرادات الطاقة، فإن النمسا تتميز تقليديًا بعجز تجاري طفيف. ونتيجة لأزمة الطاقة، كان عجز الميزان التجاري فوق 3% في عامي 2021 و2022، ولكن استعادته تمت مرة أخرى ما دون نسبة 1% في عام 2023.





وكما في السنوات السابقة، كانت ألمانيا في عام 2023 الشريك التجاري الرئيسي للنمسا من حيث حجم التجارة بفارق كبير بينها وبين الدول الأخرى. وفي حين أن الولايات المتحدة هي الشريك التجاري الذي يتمتع بأكبر فائض تجاري إيجابي للنمسا، فإن التجارة مع الصين تتميز عادة بواردات أعلى. وتستمر القائمة بشكل رئيسي بشركاء الاتحاد الأوروبي، نظرًا للقرب الجغرافي والسوق الأوروبية الواحدة التي تسهل التجارة.

 عند دراسة التبادل التجاري بصورة أكثر تفصيلًا، يتضح أن التجارة الخارجية تُبادَر في الغالب داخل إحدى الولايات الاتحادية التسع في النمسا. فمقاطعة النمسا السفلى تتألق كبطل دائم للصادرات، بينما تبرز فيينا كمساهم أساسي في أعلى مستويات الواردات، مما يضع لنا صورة واضحة لديناميات التجارة الإقليمية.

التداعيات الاقتصادية للصراعات الجيوسياسية


إن العديد من الصراعات الجيوسياسية الجارية حاليًا لا يزال تأثيرها الاقتصادي على النمسا محدودًا. فعلى سبيل المثال، تكون تأثيرات الصراعات في الشرق الأوسط على النمسا في الغالب غير مباشرة. على الرغم من أن النمسا قد لا تواجه عواقب اقتصادية مباشرة، إلا أن تداعياتها يمكن أن تكون لا تزال محسوسة من خلال اضطرابات التجارة، والتوترات الدبلوماسية، والجهود الإنسانية، والاعتبارات الأمنية. كما تبدو محدودية نشوء خطر حدوث صدمة في أسعار النفط مشابهة لحظر النفط عام 1973، حيث انخفضت التبعية الغربية نظرا لأن الولايات المتحدة أصبحت مصدرًا صافيًا لصادرات النفط الخام الآن. ومع ذلك، يمكن تصور إغلاق مسارات التجارة الهامة، مثل قناة السويس، وهذا قد يؤدي إلى تجدد مشكلات في سلسلة التوريد العالمية.

من ناحية أخرى، يظل الصراع الجاري في أوكرانيا مصدرًا هامًا للمخاطر. ومع قدوم شتاء بارد بشكل استثنائي، تتزايد احتمالية النفاد السريع لمخزونات الغاز في أوروبا، خاصة مع استمرار اعتماد المنطقة على واردات الغاز الطبيعي والنفط الخام من روسيا. ويمكن أن يؤدي مثل هذا النقص إلى تصاعد أسعار الغاز الطبيعي والوقود من جديد.





تطورات الدخل الحقيقي 1996 -2025



النمو الاقتصادي 1996- 2025 التغير في الناتج المحلي الإجمالي الحقيقي بالنسبة المئوية




النمو الاقتصادي 1996- 2025 التغير في الناتج المحلي الإجمالي الحقيقي بالنسبة المئوية



الاستيراد والتصدير للسلع 1996- 2025





معدلات التضخم 1996- 2025



Bridging Cultures, Forging Partnerships: Austria's Arab Trade Alliances

Charting Commerce: Austria's Arab Affiliations in 2023

In the fiscal year of 2023, the trade volumes between Austria and Arab nations constituted approximately 1.4% of Austria's aggregate foreign trade volume, as of preliminary data. Notably, the most significant trade activities were observed with Libya, underscoring the implementation of recent bilateral accords pertaining to oil and gas imports. Furthermore, Austria's primary export destinations within the Arab region were the United Arab Emirates (UAE), closely trailed by Saudi Arabia. These exports predominantly comprised machinery and vehicles as well as chemical products.



Recent Trade Trends Show Consistent Stability

While Austria's proportion of foreign trade volumes with Arab countries has exhibited relative stability, ranging between 1% and 1.4% of the overall foreign trade volume in recent years, there has been a significant escalation in absolute terms, particularly following the recovery from the challenging circumstances presented by the Covid-19 pandemic. Over the past two years, the most notable increases have been observed in import volumes from Saudi Arabia, registering a surge of 661% between 2021 and 2022, followed by a 146% increase in 2023, resulting in total imports amounting to 442 million EUR in 2023. This substantial rise can primarily be attributed to additional imports of fuels and energy as well as processed goods. Minor increases were also observed in imports from Oman and Mauritania. Apart from these fluctuations, trade levels have remained relatively stable over the past three years.

In absolute terms, Libya continues to hold the top position in trade volumes with Austria. However, attention should be directed to a significant increase in imports from Libya compared to pre-Covid times, primarily driven by the initiation of new energy supply agreements.



Diving Deeper: Austrian Federal Provinces and Trade Relations with Arab Nations

On a global scale, Upper Austria exhibits prominence as Austria's foremost trading entity. However, in the context of trade engagements with Arab nations, Lower Austria distinguishes itself by boasting the most substantial trade volume among the provinces, accompanied by a remarkable surplus in imports. This notable trend can be attributed to the influx of imports predominantly within the petrochemical, oil, and gas sectors, wherein Austria's principal corporations and facilities operating within this sphere are predominantly situated in Lower Austria.



التقاء الثقافات وتعزيز الشراكات: التحالفات التجارية النمساوية العربية

قراءة في العلاقات التجارية العربية النمساوية للعام 2023

بلغ حجم التبادل التجاري بين النمسا والدول العربية في عام 2023 نسبة نحو 1.4% من إجمالي حجم التجارة الخارجية للنمسا. وتشير الأرقام إلى أن أكبر حجم للتبادل التجاري كان مع ليبيا، في إشارة إلى دخول الاتفاقيات الثنائية بين البلدين والمتعلقة بواردات النفط والغاز حيز التنفيذ. أما فيما يتعلق بالصادرات فكانت دولة الإمارات العربية المتحدة الوجهة الرئيسية للنمسا في المنطقة العربية، فيما حلت تاليا المملكة العربية السعودية. ومثلت هذه الصادرات بشكل أساسي الآلات والمركبات بالإضافة إلى المنتجات الكيميائية.



الاتجاهات التجارية الأخيرة تظهر ثبات مستوياتها

في الوقت الذي استقرت فيه مستويات حجم التجارة الخارجية بين النمسا والدول العربية في السنوات الأخيرة؛ حيث تراوحت النسبة بين 1% و 1.4% من الحجم الإجمالي للتجارة الخارجية للنمسا، فقد لوحظ تصاعدًا كبيرًا من حيث القيم المطلقة؛ خاصة بعد التعافي من التحديات التي فرضتها جائحة كوفيد-19 خلال العامين المنصرمين. وبدت زيادات ملحوظة خاصة في حجم الواردات من المملكة العربية السعودية؛ حيث سجلت زيادة قدرها 661% بين عامي 2021 و 2022، تلتها زيادة بنسبة 146% في عام 2023، بواقع واردات إجمالية بلغت 442 مليون يورو في عام 2023. وتُنسب هذه الزيادة الكبيرة في الأساس إلى الواردات الإضافية من الوقود والطاقة بالإضافة إلى السلع المصنعة. كما لوحظت زيادات طفيفة في الواردات من عُمان وموريتانيا. وبغض الطرف عن هذه التقلبات، فقد بقيت مستويات التجارة ثابتة نسبيا طوال السنوات الثلاث الماضية.

ولا تزال ليبيا تحتل المرتبة الأولى في حجم التبادل التجاري مع النمسا. مع ملاحظة الطفرة الكبيرة في حجم الواردات من ليبيا مقارنة بفترة ما قبل الجائحة؛ حيث يرجع ذلك إلى دخول اتفاقيات جديدة لتوفير الطاقة حيز التنفيذ.




المقاطعات الفيدرالية النمساوية والعلاقات التجارية مع الدول العربية


